Please Read the Following Information.

Admission and Medical Forms:

South East Consortium is required to keep a completed up-to-date admissions application and medical form on file for all program participants. Participants who have expired information on file will be required to update the information prior to participating in any South East programs.

Registration Restriction: If a participant has an outstanding balance due to South East for attending previous programs, that participant will not be permitted to register for the new session until the outstanding balance is paid.

Late Pick-up Policy: Late pick-ups and early drop offs are continuing to create several problems for us especially when a facility needs to remain open (expensive) and staff need to provide extended supervision (more expensive) before or after program time. We understand an occasional glitch in your schedule, but if this becomes a trend you will be billed \$10 for every additional 15 minutes staff is required to provide supervision either before or after program schedule times.

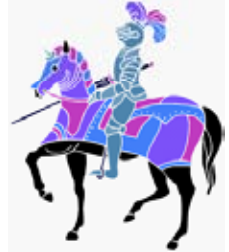

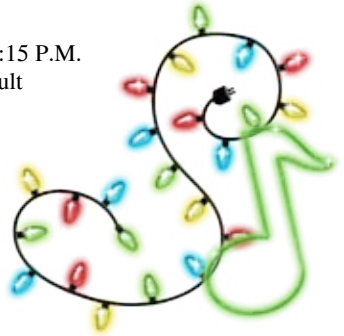
